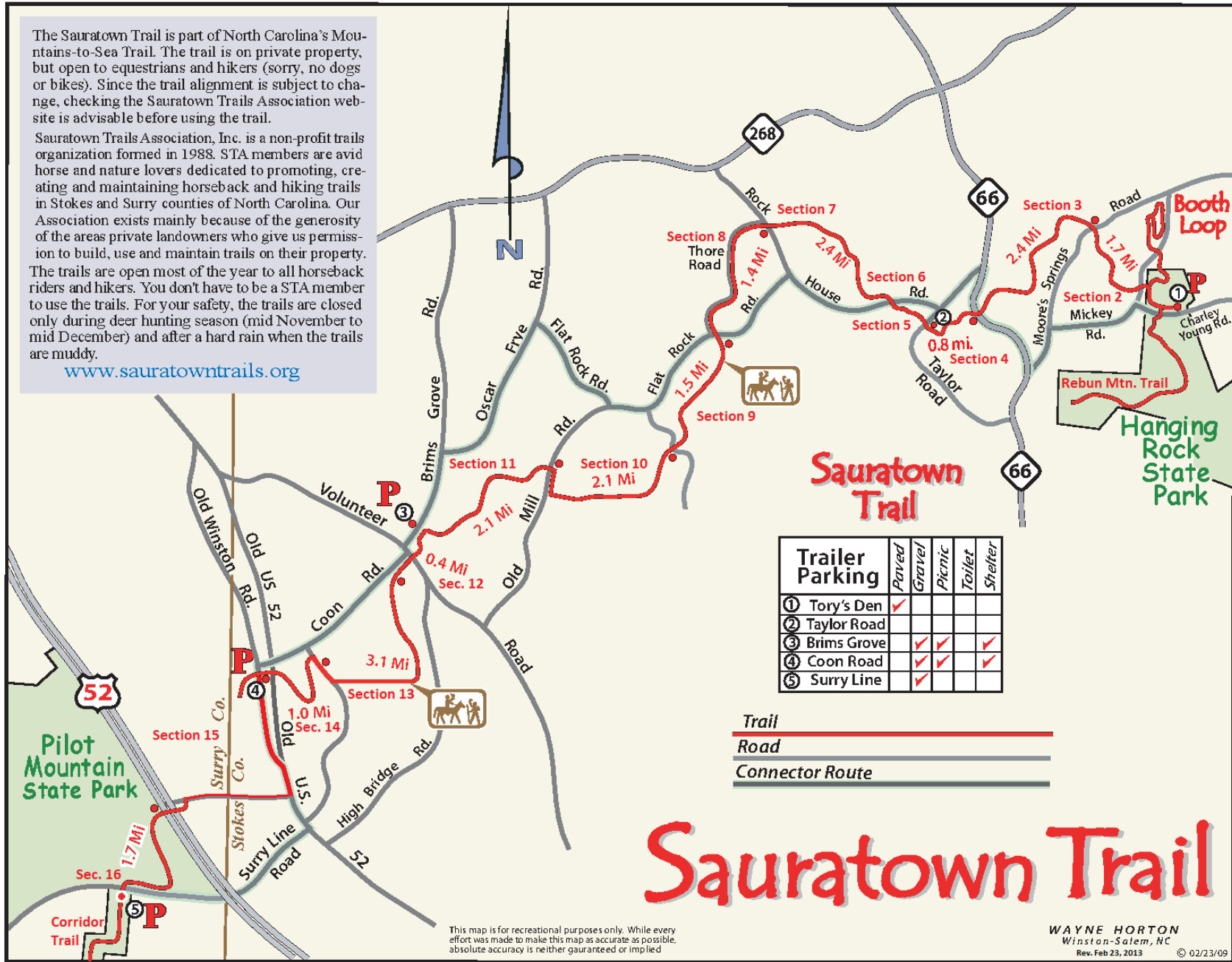


The Sauratown Trail is part of North Carolina's Mountains-to-Sea Trail. The trail is on private property, but open to equestrians and hikers (sorry, no dogs or bikes). Since the trail alignment is subject to change, checking the Sauratown Trails Association website is advisable before using the trail.

Sauratown Trails Association, Inc. is a non-profit trails organization formed in 1988. STA members are avid horse and nature lovers dedicated to promoting, creating and maintaining horseback and hiking trails in Stokes and Surry counties of North Carolina. Our Association exists mainly because of the generosity of the areas private landowners who give us permission to build, use and maintain trails on their property. The trails are open most of the year to all horseback riders and hikers. You don't have to be a STA member to use the trails. For your safety, the trails are closed only during deer hunting season (mid November to mid December) and after a hard rain when the trails are muddy.
